How unexpected it was to find a dusting of snow on our mountains when we woke up in mid-September! This definitely makes it more realistic that winter is approaching and that you need to start making plans now. Here is a short Fall check list:

- Clean your electric wall and baseboard heaters
- Change your filters if you have FAU heating
- Check for interior openings (under sinks, appliances, etc) that need to be filled so the mice do not enter.
- Change your batteries on your digital thermostats
- Buy a snow shovel for your Unit and clearly mark with your Unit number
- Have ice-melt readily available by your front door
- Place your order for fireplace wood

As a reminder: September and October are HOA Fire Safety months **Again, please note the maintenance dates below on your calendar, as access inside your unit will be necessary.**

We want to let you know that a number of Homeowner Associations in Mammoth Lakes have received non-renewal notices from State Farm and other varying Insurance Companies. We believe this also impacts the renewal of individual homeowner policies (HO6). If you are insured by State Farm, we encourage you to speak with your agent.
