NOTICE OF PROCEDURE FOR ELECTING 2026-27 BOARD MEMBERS, REVISIONS TO ELECTION RULES AND TIMELINE

Greetings!

In 2021, the Mammoth Estates HOA approved revisions to the HOA Bylaws, consistent with the provisions of Civil Code 5103, allowing for the **option of electing members of the board by acclamation of the current Board of Directors when the number of candidates for open board positions is equal to or less than the number of board seats.**

Furthermore, at its November 2024 Board meeting, the Board approved revisions to the Mammoth Estates HOA Election Rules and the timeline for the election of board members. **The revised Election Rules and Election timeline may be found here:**

This notice provides you with information about the procedures that will be used to solicit candidates for election to the board and the process for electing Board Members.

(A) There are 7 Mammoth Estates HOA Board positions. All 7 board positions will be filled by this election. The qualifications for Board Members are identified in the Election Rules and the Bylaws, both of which are posted on the Mammoth Estates HOA website:

(D) Please note that if, at the end of the **May 10, 2026** nomination deadline, there are the same number or fewer qualified candidates as there are board positions to be filled, then the board of directors may, after voting to do so, seat the qualified candidates by acclamation without balloting.

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
